WHO CAN ATTEND?

CUB SCOUTS—BOY SCOUTS—VENTURERS—Come join us for a weekend of Family Camp at Chesebrough Scout Reservation, located near the coast in the beautiful California redwoods of Santa Cruz County. The Entire family, not just Scouts and Parents, may attend Family Camp weekends. Bring along Grandparents, older and younger Siblings, your Best Friends plus their Families and other relatives who enjoy the Great Outdoors. It is also a great place to spend quality time with your son if you prefer a one-on-one experience. Camp opens on Saturday, May 29th at 4:00 PM.

CAMPING:

Camping is in designated areas only.

- ◆ Tent sites—bring your own tent to pitch. Gear will need to be carried into your campsite; a camp truck will be available for larger bulky items as needed.

MEALS

Meals are served as follows: Breakfast is at 8 AM, Lunch is at 12 PM and Dinner is served at 6 PM. We do attempt to assist with special diets; *however*, such dietary restrictions need to be addressed *prior* to arriving at camp. Please contact the Camp Director at the Council Service Center, 408-280-2154 x39, regarding such needs. For those arriving Saturday evening, a buffet -style Dinner will be served from 6:00 PM to 7:00 PM.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

Every attempt, within common safety guidelines, is made to offer the full outdoor program each day. Special “rainy day” program features may be substituted for some activities if the weather warrants it. Regardless, all programs will take place rain or shine. Refunds are not available due to inclement weather unless the camp is cancelled.

WHAT TO BRING

Sleeping bags & sleeping pads, change of clothes, flashlight, jacket/sweater, towel for a hot shower and an appetite for great food and fun! You may also want to bring a camera, and a lantern for your campsite and spending money for the camp trading post. Please label as many of your belongings as possible with your name and unit number.

ACTIVITIES:

- Nature—guided walks, wander by yourself or visit the nature area to make your favorite animal track mold
- Climbing—fun for all ages on our 26-foot climbing wall.
- Archery—traditional target archery.
- Shooting Sports—BB guns
- Campfire Program—Sunday night enjoy songs, skits and stories lead by the camp staff.
- Activities available for everyone-volleyball, horseshoes, crafts, plus much, much more! And yes it's OK to lay under a tree, read a book, or just relax in the beauty of camp.
- Trading Post—The camp store offers fun and interesting projects that can be made while at camp along with snack and food items, snow cones, convenience items and camp souvenirs.

REGISTRATION

- 1) Register by individual families (please include friends and relatives attending with you). Unit registration is not required although we do our best to camp members of the same unit in the same campground area, or nearby.
- 2) **Registration opens March 1, 2010- CLOSES May 22, 2010**
(space is limited – don't miss the FUN!!)
- 3) **Reservation fees must be paid for at the time of registration.**
- 4) Annual Health & Medical Record (34605) is required for every adult and child attending camp. Please complete these forms and bring them to camp with you when you come. No minor under the age of 18 is allowed to remain in camp without a completed Health History & Consent form on file. You need only to have Part A & C completed at minimum.
