Qualifications and Instructions

Complete and mail this application to Santa Clara County Council, Boy Scouts of America, Eagle Scout Scholarship, 970 W Julian Ave, San Jose, CA 95126. Applications will not be considered if **postmarked** later than midnight January 1. The applicant must complete this personally and he must meet the following requirements:

1. Be currently registered in the Boy Scouts of America.
2. Have been granted the Eagle Scout Award. Applicants should ensure that they have been certified as an Eagle Scout prior to submission of the application.
3. Be a graduating high school senior and an entering college freshman in the year he is applying for a scholarship. Grants are awarded only to high school seniors graduating in the calendar year in which scholarships are presented. Those Scouts whose Eagle Scout boards of review are held between January 1 and July 31 of their graduating year may apply in the following year.
4. Have and SAT score of at least 800. Applicants must take the SAT in time to submit the results with the application.
5. Have demonstrated leadership ability in Scouting and a strong record of participation in activities outside of Scouting.
6. Possess a financial need.

Scholarships granted are on a one-time basis and are not renewable. No more than 10 pages may be attached to this application. All attachments must include:

1. A letter of recommendation from Scoutmaster or other Scout leader outlining the applicants experiences in Scouting,
2. A transcript of high school grades covering six semesters (SAT test scores must be included-documentation must be submitted with application).
3. A personal resume.
4. A current photo (optional).

The selection committee will inform all applicants of results by January 21. The presentation will take place at the Council Annual Dinner.

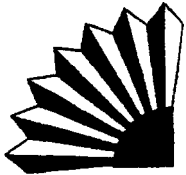
