Santa Clara County Council is pleased to offer one of the premiere Cub Scout summer camp programs in California. With 18 unique program opportunities, including 12 day camps, 3 twilight camps one Cub adventure camp and 2 Webelos camps, we will host over 1,000 Cub Scouts and Webelos. We have a challenge to provide those who attend our camps with the best summer experience they will ever have.

Opportunities to serve Scouting as a member of the Cub camp staff are available to outstanding applicants.

Applicants are considered for positions without regard to race, color, religion, sex, national origin, age, or the presence of a health problem or handicap that is related to your ability to perform the jobs requested.

- The minimum age accepted for youth volunteers is 11. Boy Scouts of America standards require minimum ages of 14 for some positions.
- All staff are expected to be available for the entire period of the camp or camps for which they are selected. They are also expected to attend pre-season training and planning meetings as required by the camps or positions for which they are selected.
- The position of **Den Chief** is for Scouts at least 14 years old. The **Den Chief** is a role model to cub scouts and provides leadership by assisting the adult Den Guides in the management of the den. The **Den Chief**'s responsibilities include assisting the scouts during station activities and lunch, leads flag ceremony practice sessions, and is supervised by the adult Den Guides.
- The position of **Station Assistant** is for Scouts at least 11 years old. The **Station Assistant** supports the station host and helps explain and lead the activities at that station. The responsibilities of the **Station Assistant** depend upon the particular station, and the age and experience of the Scout, and is directly supervised by the adult station hosts.
- All staff members must be registered with the Boy Scouts of America prior to employment.
- The standards of the Scout Oath and Scout Law must be adhered to at all times.
- The staff sets an example of Scouting excellence, which includes the proper wearing of the designated camp uniform, and the proper use of camp equipment, materials and supplies while in camp.
