## Pack Checklist for Success

**Every** youth should have a great opportunity this summer to go to camp. By recruiting a pack camp coordinator and following this checklist, your pack is aiming for a great summer.

- Choose a parent who is excited about Cub camp or the pack committee chair to help get everyone on board for camp.
- Present your pack with all camp locations, fees, and times from the website at [www.scccbsa.org/cubcamp](http://www.scccbsa.org/cubcamp) or from the grid above.
- Arrange for a blue and gold presentation by a Cub camp team member.
- Help the pack select their primary camp location and date.
- Inform the pack of overnight camping opportunities.
- Find 2 - 3 motivated parents to work as a station host at camp, guaranteeing 12 slots for your Cubs and station hosts registration starting January 16th.
- Collect all personal information (using the sample form at [www.scccbsa.org/cubcamp](http://www.scccbsa.org/cubcamp)) and fees for each Cub and adult attending camp.
- Go to [www.scccbsa.org/cubcamp](http://www.scccbsa.org/cubcamp), starting February 1, to register everyone for Cub camp.
- Families in need can apply for camperships offered by the Santa Clara County Council.
- Check the website often and keep the pack informed on all Cub camp information as it comes out at [www.scccbsa.org/cubcamp](http://www.scccbsa.org/cubcamp).
