

## Registering for Camp – Pack recommendations

Thank you for your interest in the 2008 Cub Scout Summer Camp programs. Registering for camp this year is simpler and easier than ever before. All registration information will be submitted online. Every camp is different and unique. A Cub can register for one or as many as they can attend. Registering for camp can be done individually by families or as a Pack. If you are registering as a Pack, here are a few tips to help make your registration process smooth and easy.

1. Review all of the camp options with your families and determine which camp(s) they will be attending.
2. Have each family complete Cub Scout and Adult worksheets. ( Cub Form: [http://www.scccbsa.org/files/2008\\_program\\_camping\\_cubcamp\\_scoutworksheet.pdf](http://www.scccbsa.org/files/2008_program_camping_cubcamp_scoutworksheet.pdf) Adult Form: [http://www.scccbsa.org/files/2008\\_program\\_camping\\_cubcamp\\_adultworksheet.pdf](http://www.scccbsa.org/files/2008_program_camping_cubcamp_adultworksheet.pdf) ) All items in bold will be required. (Remember that Cubs are encouraged to sign up for multiple camps if desired) Every Cub that signs up for a Day, Twilight or Cub Adventure Camp will need an Adult worksheet filled out for their parent/guardian. Cubs attending Webelos camp with a parent will need an Adult worksheet. Cubs attending **ONLY** Webelos Camp do not need the adult information form if their parents are **NOT** attending.
3. Collect all individual payments. [Please note: Payments made online will be charged a small processing fee that will be paid directly to the credit card company. If you would like to collect in advance from the parents, figure about \$3 per \$100 in camp fees.] Alternatively, you will have the option to pay by check within 7 days of your registration via mail or at the council service center. See #4 for details. (Camperships may be available on a need basis. For details, see [http://www.scccbsa.org/files/2008\\_program\\_camping\\_campership.pdf](http://www.scccbsa.org/files/2008_program_camping_campership.pdf) )
4. There are three (3) payment options. 1) You can pay by credit card at the time of registration. 2) You can pay by electronic check at the time of registration. [Note: if you use this option, you should have a blank check handy when you begin the online process so that you will have the necessary account information.] 3) You can pay by check or credit card **within 7 days** of the completion of your online registration. Payment can be made via mail or brought to the council service center. Instructions for making the payment will be on your receipt. Please note that if payment is not received **within 7 days**, your registration is subject to cancellation or demotion to a waiting list.
5. There is a lot of important information to collect so anticipate about **10 minutes per scout** to register. (If you have a large number of scouts to register, you can register several at a time instead of all at once.)
6. This will help guide you step by step through the various screens.
