**Schedule:**

Come prepared to camp! We will be sleeping in the great outdoors. We have access to covered areas, so we are training rain or shine!

Class 1 Health Form (available on [sccc-scouting.org](http://sccc-scouting.org)) Sleeping bag, Webelos Leader Uniform (wear it), Tent, Flashlight, Rain Gear, Toiletries, Blanket (if you tend to get cold), Pens and pencils, Eating utensils, Coffee cup, Extra clothes, Any medications, Webelos handbook, Pocket Knife, Layers (shirts/sweaters) to adjust because Chesebrough weather can be unpredictable, and can get VERY cold and damp at times. Bring lots of layers of clothing to stay comfortable night and day. Be Prepared!
