

## 2010 National Jamboree

### Participant Refund Policy

Scouts interested in attending the 2010 National Jamboree must submit a deposit of \$100 with their applications. The deposit will be applied to the total cost of Jamboree and touring fees.

If the Scout is selected to attend the 2010 National Jamboree but elects to withdraw from participation, the Scout may apply to the Council for a partial refund of the deposit. The Council will retain a portion of the deposit to cover costs incurred.

- Refund requests must be made in writing and be approved by the Scout Executive and the Jamboree Chairman.
- If postmarked before December 31, 2009, refunds will be made as follows. All fees paid to date, less the \$100 reservation fee, a \$50 administration fee, will be refunded in full.
- After December 31, 2009 refunds will only be made if there is an alternate\*. Refunds will include total amount paid, less (\$150) the \$100 reservation fee, a \$100 administration fee, and other expenses related to contractual agreements made on behalf of the local council Jamboree.
- After June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010 no refunds will be made.

Scouts are expected to make regular progress payments toward the full cost of Jamboree and touring fees. A schedule of progress payments will be provided to all Scouts selected to attend the 2010 National Jamboree.

\* An alternate may be selected from the council waiting list, if there is one, or could be a properly qualified youth recruited by the person requesting a refund.

- If there is no alternate, a partial refund will be made. Refunds will include total amount paid, less the \$100 reservation fee, a \$100 administration fee, and other expenses related to contractual agreements made on behalf of the local council Jamboree.
